-Installation of Seven Bank ATMs which Accept Cards Issued Overseas in the Tokyo International Forum and the Imperial Hotel from October 7 to October 14, 2012-

Seven Bank, Ltd. (Seven Bank or the Bank) announced today that it will provide ATM services in the two main venues during the holding of the Annual Meetings of the International Monetary Fund (IMF) and the World Bank Group and related events.

Commencement of services will enable customers visiting Japan from overseas, including senior government officials, bankers and financiers, journalists and others from countries around the world, to withdraw money (Japanese yen) using their cash and credit cards.

Seven Bank will continue to install ATMs in various locations to meet customers' needs and to ensure convenient access to ATMs for as many customers as possible.

- 1. Installation location: The Tokyo International Forum and the Imperial Hotel
- 2. Service period: From October 7, 2012 (Sunday) to October 14, 2012 (Sunday)
 - * The service in the Imperial Hotel is scheduled to commence from October 8, 2012 (Monday)
- 3. Number of ATMs: Two in the Tokyo International Forum and one in the Imperial Hotel
- 4. Accepted cards
 - (1) Visa (including Plus), Mastercard (including Maestro and Cirrus), American Express, Diners Club, JCB, China Union Pay, and Discover cards issued overseas.
 - (2) Cards issued in Japan from more than 580 financial institutions, including banks, shinkin banks, credit cooperatives, labor banks, JA Bank, JF Marine Bank, Shoko Chukin Bank, securities companies, life insurance companies, credit card companies, consumer credit companies, consumer finance companies, and business finance companies.
